King of all Serbian lands, Raska, Duklja, Travunia, Dalmatia and Zahumlje (Hum). Wide area from river Neretva on the west to river South Morava on the east and from Mountain Rudnik on the north to Adriatic Sea on the south. From the city of Skadar to Split. The original Serbian state.
